Minutes of Meeting held on 13th December, 2016

- 1) **Attendance** – Cllr. Norman Osborne chaired the monthly meeting with Cllrs. C Smith, D Adey, P Chapman, R Reason and two members of the public attending. Apologies received from Cllrs. I Franklyn, R Fox and County Cllr. Nicky Chopak.
- 2) **Declarations/Dispensations** – There were no Declarations/Dispensations in respect of this agenda.
- 3) **Minutes** - The minutes of the previous meeting were read and signed as correct.
- 4) **Salt Bins** – It was noted that the Salt Bins had not yet been filled.
- 5) **Notice Boards** – Clerk to write a letter to Mr P Sousek pointing out that the Notice Boards are for Community events and not for business advertising . State that if this persists action will have to be taken.
- 6) **Balance** – It was noted that the balance at the bank is £14,694.68 in the Current A/C and £8376.12 in the Primrose A/C
- 7) **Cornwall Local Plan Strategic Policies 2010 -2030** - Clerk to send copy of Email to Councillors to read with relevant documents to view On-line.
- 8) **Cornwall Council Recycling** – Cornwall Council advised that from March 2017 Plastic Pots, Tubs and Trays etc. will be recyclable. Information will be sent to every household.
- 9) **Enforcement EN16/01643 – Westcott, Jacobstow** – Enforcement Officer advised that no further action will be taken on this case.
- 10) **Town & Parish Council Elections – 4th May 2017** – Cornwall Council advised the estimated cost to the Parish of a Contested Election will be £2,261.31 and an Uncontested election would be £310.94.
- 11) **Parish & Town Council Precepts for 2017/18 Financial Year** – It was discussed and agreed to ask for a Precept of £4,000.00 this year. Proposed Cllr. Adey, Seconded Cllr. Smith.

12) Superfast Broadband – The Head Mistress of the school received an Email promising Superfast Broadband within the next calendar year.

13) Plymwood Cross Sign – Clerk to Email Oliver Jones regarding a Road Sign at Plymwood Cross . This steel sign was taken away about ten years ago for repair and was never returned. Also report that a 30mph sign at Wainhouse Corner has been knocked over.
