Minutes of Meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> January 2018

- 1) **Attendance** – Cllr. Osborne chaired the monthly meeting of the Parish Council with Cllrs. C Smith, P Chapman, D Adey, C Pallett, County Cllr. Nicky Chopak and four members of the Public attending. Apologies received from Cllrs. I Franklyn and R Fox.
  - 2) **Declarations** – There were no declarations or dispensations for this Agenda.
  - 3) **Minutes** - The minutes of the previous meeting were read and signed as correct.
  - 4) **Balance** – It was noted that the balance at the bank is £12,364.85 in the Current A/c and £4,700 12. In the Primrose A/C.
  - 5) **Repairs to Fence at Holy Well** – Mrs Carter reported that the fence and gate at the Holy Well needs repairing.
  - 6) **Grant Application – Jacobstow Church** – The Grant application from the Church was again discussed and it was unanimously agreed to grant them £500 towards the restoration of two very old paintings. Proposed Cllr. Adey Seconded Cllr. Smith.
  - 7) **Cornwall Council – Citizens Advice Cornwall** – Cornwall Council reinforced its commitment to finding a sustainable future for Citizens Advice Cornwall. They are considering whether they can offer them space in Cornwall Council buildings to cut their overheads.
  - 8) **Cornwall Council – Council Tax Referendum** – The government has said that it will defer the setting of referendum principles for Town & Parish Councils for three years.
  - 9) **Resignation** – Cllr. Fox wrote a letter of resignation to the Chairman as he has now moved out of the area.
  - 10) **Councillor Matters** – Cllr. Osborne informed that the Superfast Broadband should be ready by the end of January.
