

JACOBSTOW PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of Meeting held on 4th October 2016

- 1) **Attendance** – Cllr. Osborne chaired the monthly meeting with Cllrs. D Adey, P Chapman, I Franklyn, R Fox, County Cllr. Nicky Chopak and three members of the Public attending. Apologies received from Cllrs. R Reason & C Smith. There were no Declarations of Interest/Dispensations.
- 2) **Minutes** – The minutes of the previous meeting were read and signed as correct.
- 3) **Car Sales** – It was mentioned that even though the vehicles at the Car Sales Business have been kept further back there is still a Car Wash Sign blocking the view to turn right towards Bude. Cllr. Chopak to deal with this.
- 4) **Balance** - The balance at the Bank is £12,853.44 (Current A/C) and £8376.12 (Primrose A/C)
- 5) **Notice Board** - It was agreed a Polite note should be kept in the Notice Board saying that this is for Parish Functions and not for business's to advertise.
- 6) **Tesco – Bags of Help** - This is a new grant programme funded through the money raised from the 5p bag charge in Tesco stores in England., Correspondence passed to the School, Football Club, etc.
- 7) **Electoral Review** - Electoral Review Panel is putting forward proposal for future size of Cornwall Council.
- 8) **Grant Applications** – Further discussion was had on the Application received from Jacobstow Amblers. It was agreed that Cllrs. Osborne & Chapman visit Mrs Mary Carter to discuss the project with her.
- 9) **Grant Thornton** - An account was received from Grant Thornton for the Audit which had been completed amounting to £120.00 Proposed we pay Cllr. Chapman Seconded Cllr. Franklyn.
- 10) **Grant Letters** – Letters of thanks received from all the Organizations that a Grant was paid to.

11) Cornwall Council – Westcott, Jacobstow – Alleged conversion of garage into an annex being used for residential purposes. This matter has been formally registered and allocated to a Development Officer for investigation.

12) Road Closure - Road Closure on the A39 between Treskinnick Cross & Wainhouse Corner. 31st October – 4th November 2016.

13) BT Telephone Kiosk – Clerk to write to BT asking if we can keep this Kiosk working as mobile signal in Jacobstow has intermittent reception.

14) Bude Community Network – It was noted that the next meeting ‘is 10th October, 2016. Cllr Osborne said he would attend.

15) Cornwall Council – Household Rubbish & Recycling collections – Email received asking what we think about the services we receive. Clerk to complete the survey on line.

16) Letter from Scott Mann – Reply received from Scott Mann saying that as the School’s telephone provider is not BT they cannot help. Cllr Osborne taking the letter to the School to discuss.

17) CALC – Government Consultation on the Extension of Referendum Principles. This was noted.

18) Emergency Building Database. – Form amended with names of keyholders and returned.

19) Councillor Matters - Filling the Salt Bins ready for the winter was discussed Cllr. Adey to deal with this. Cllr Franklyn mentioned that she would like a Salt Bin on the corner, near her house.
