Minutes of Meeting held on 1st November, 2016

- 1. **Attendance** – Cllr. Norman Osborne chaired the monthly meeting of the Parish Council with a full attendance of Councillors, County Cllr. Nicky Chopak and two members of the Public.*
- 2. **Declarations/Dispensations** – There were no Declarations or Dispensations for this Agenda.*
- 3. **Minutes** – The minutes of the previous meeting were read and signed as correct.*
- 4. **Balance at Bank** – It was reported that the balance at the bank is £15,188.07 in the Current A/C and £8376.12 in the Primrose A/C.*
- 5. **Salt Bins** – Cllr Adey reported that the Salt Bins will be filled within the next two weeks. The one at the School needs sorting as it has gone hard.*
- 6. **Notice Board** – A note to be kept in the Notice Board saying that it is for Parish Functions only.*
- 7. **Bude Community Network Meeting** - Cllr. Osborne reported on the recent Network meeting he had attended. We need a representative to attend each meeting.*
- 8. **Parish Footpaths** – Cllrs Osborne & Chapman had met with Mrs Mary Carter regarding the proposed Kissing Gates to replace the stiles. The Owners permission is required for this. Cornwall Council will pay for the equipment.*
- 9. **Kernow Matters to you – Say No to Devonwall** – Correspondence Emailed to Councillors to read before the meeting. It was decided not to object as a Council but individuals can object if they so wish.*
- 10. **Grant Application** – Application received from the Parish Hall Committee for the Pensioners Christmas Lunch. Cllrs. R.Fox, I.Franklyn and R.Reason left the room while this was discussed. It was agreed this was not a suitable project to claim for. County Cllr. Nicky Chopak offered to give a donation from her allowance and she will arrange for the necessary claim form to be sent to the Clerk for completion.*

11. Planning Application – Oakdene, Edgar Road, Wainhouse Corner –
PA16/02485. Outline Planning being sought. Advised Pending decision.

12. Pay Clerk – *It was agreed to pay the Clerk her Salary in December. This amounted to £454.00 plus Expenses of £39.39. Total £493.39 Proposed Cllr. Chapman Seconded Cllr. Fox.*

13. Councillor Matters – *The School Broadband speed was again discussed. The School pay the line rental to BT but they don't do the Security the School need so the Broadband is not with BT. Clerk to write to Scott Mann asking again what can be done.*
